## **Press Release**

Drugs Control Administration, Telangana raided Bright Hospital, Jagtial which is running a pharmacy without a drug licence and seized huge quantity of drugs worth Rs. 2.10 lakhs stocked for sale.

Drugs Control Administration, Telangana officials, on credible information, raided Bright Hospital, located at D.No. 7-1-191 & 192, Santosh Nagar, Jagtial Town on 24<sup>th</sup> January, 2024 and detected unauthorized stocking of huge quantity of medicines for sale.

During the raid, DCA officials detected huge stocks of medicines found stocked at the premises without any drug licence. 55 varieties of medicines including antibiotics, steroids, pain killer drugs, anti-ulcer drugs, cough syrups, antacids etc. are found stocked at the premises.

DCA officials seized the stock of total worth **Rs. 2.10 lakhs** during the raid.

Sri. N. Narsaiah, Assistant Director, Nizamabad and Sri. V. Upender, Drugs Inspector, Jagtial carried out the raid.

DCA officers lifted the samples for analysis. Further investigation shall be carried out and action shall be taken as per the law against all the offenders.

Drugs Control Administration, Telangana has been constantly on the vigil and alert to detect unlicensed stocking and sale of medicines.

Stocking of drugs for sale without a drug licence is punishable under Drugs and Cosmetics Act with an imprisonment up to five years.

Surprise checks are intensified on such entities that are carrying out stocking and sale of drugs without any drug licence. Stringent action shall be taken as per the law against violators.
